Regulations

The Foreign Exchange (Classes of Capital Transactions Undertaken in Sri Lanka by a Person Resident Outside Sri Lanka) Regulations No. 2 of 2021 published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* Notification No. 2213/35 dated 03 February 2021, as amended, issued under the Foreign Exchange Act, No. 12 of 2017 (the Regulations), are hereby further amended as follows:-

- (i) Sub paragraph (9) of the paragraph 1 under heading A of the Part I of the Schedule of the Regulations are hereby repealed without prejudice to anything done thereunder.

(ii) Item (e) of sub paragraph (1) of the paragraph 4 under heading A of the Part I of the Schedule of the Regulations is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

“(e) Repayment of loans already granted with a tenure of less than three years to companies as defined in the Companies Act, No. 7 of 2007 in Sri Lanka, under the Regulations No. 2 of 2021 (as amended) is permitted to be repaid by way of conversion of Sri Lanka Rupees, where the borrower of such loan has no sufficient foreign exchange balances/cash flows to repay such loan”.
